Arrival and Departure:

Campers should be there on Sunday August 22th by 1300

Departure time on Friday August 27th is @ 1300

Medical policy:

Elim Community Church requires each camper to have a Sports/Camp examination within two years of the opening day of camp. This exam must be verified by the Physicians Statement of Examination

being filled out. The authorization for treatment on the statement of health section must be signed. All prescription medication must be brought to camp in their original containers with prescribed instructions. For more information contact the Pastor.

What to bring:

Sleeping bag, pillow, sleep wear, flashlight, towels, wash cloths, personal care items, sneakers, extra shoes, swim wear, appropriate clothing (Elim Community Church rules apply), Bible and notebook, a pen/pencil, camera and film.

What not to bring:

TV's, hand-held video games, fishing gear, playing cards, improper magazines and books, knives, firearms, drugs, cigarettes/tobacco, fireworks, and Bad attitudes.

Rules and Regulations:

These rules are given as guidelines for every camper to follow. This code of conduct has been established for your protection and the benefit for every person present. They must be obeyed at all times. You have pledged yourself to abide by this code during the week you are here.

- 1) The daily schedule must be observed by all and attendance at all camp activities are required.
- 2) No one is to leave camp grounds without specific permission from Pastor
- 3) All cars will be parked at the designated area. Keys must be turned in upon arrival
- 4) Each camper will perform his/her duties as part of the privilege of being here.
- 5) Rooms and grounds must be kept clean.
- 6) Guys and Gals are not allowed in each other's sleeping areas.
- 7) You must obey all your supervisors/leaders at all times.

Dress code:

The dress code is the same rules that have applied at all church functions. If you have any questions about this please contact the church office or Pastor.

The lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect of property, or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any camper will result in expulsion from camp. Parents are asked to help explain these rules to their children and encourage compliance while at camp. Parents will be responsible for the transportation home of any dismissed camper. No refunds will be given.
